Medicinal cannabis

About this product

Your cannabis product has been made specifically for your pet by your veterinarian using a high-quality CBD isolate concentrate.

What the product may be used for

Your veterinarian may have authorised the use of cannabis for the relief of one or more of the following symptoms associated with a variety of conditions that have not responded to conventional medical treatments.

Some examples may include:

- osteoarthritic pain
- chronic pain
- anxiety
- skin conditions
- age-related cognitive dysfunction
- poor appetite
- inflammatory conditions
- seizure/epilepsy
- cancer pain
- palliative care support.

This is not an exhaustive list of symptoms or conditions that cannabis can help treat.

The potential therapeutic and adverse effects associated with cannabis use may vary depending on the amount of cannabis used and the concentration of cannabinoids in the cannabis product. For more detailed information on potential therapeutic uses and adverse effects, please consult your veterinarian.

Active ingredients

This product contains cannabidiol (CBD).

CBD represents the most valuable compound from the cannabis plant with many potential therapeutic effects and is very low risk. This product contains NO THC or other parts of the cannabis plant.

The carrier oil used in your CBD Oil is MCT oil (medium chain triglyceride oil).



What the product does

CBD interacts with the body's endocannabinoid system (ECS). The ECS is comprised of receptors, endocannabinoids and enzymes, and is involved in the regulation of many body systems and functions. CBD is also able to interact with other receptors in the body. CBD has the potential to provide many therapeutic benefits.

When the product should not be used

Unless recommended by your veterinarian, it is not recommended to use cannabis in breeding, pregnant, lactating or young animals.

Interactions with this product

Cannabis may interact with several drugs, so it's important to inform your veterinarian of any prescription drugs, non-prescription drugs or herbal products you are giving your pet.

Dosing administration and routes of administration

Dosing depends on your pet's size and condition and in most instances relies on titration, which means finding the right dose where potential therapeutic effects are maximised while adverse effects are minimised.

Patients starting cannabis medicine for the first time often begin at a low dose and increase the dose as directed and monitored by their veterinarian. Please consult your veterinarian for additional information on dosing, including what to do in case of accidental overdosing.

Potential side effects

Medicinal cannabis obtained through veterinary prescription is considered a safe medicine for pets and adverse side effects are uncommon. Your pet may experience sedation and/or diarrhoea. If your pet experiences any undesirable side effects, please contact your veterinarian.

How the product is supplied

Your pet has been prescribed CBD oil. This is intended to be taken orally (by mouth) only.

How to store the product

CBD oil should be stored in a cool, dry place, away from light and air, such as a cupboard. It is not recommended to store your oil in the fridge, even in hot climates.

Keep out of reach of children and other pets. Always keep cannabis products in a safe place to prevent theft, misuse or accidental ingestion. This product is for animal use only and should not be shared with other patients.
